Student Expectations

This course includes lecture and hands-on training. You will need the following equipment to participate during the sessions indicated:

- Helmet
- Coat
- Pants
- Boots
- Gloves (firefighting gloves are acceptable, however extrication/work gloves are preferred)
- Eye protection (helmet eye shields are acceptable, however safety glasses are preferred)
- Flashlight
- Session 1 Lecture followed by hands-on evolutions (PPE Required)
- Session 2 Lecture followed by hands-on evolutions (PPE Required)
- Session 3 Lecture followed by hands-on evolutions (PPE Required)
- Session 4 Lecture followed by hands-on evolutions (PPE Required)

To successfully participate in this course, you must have already completed Firefighter I (pre-requisite) or Scene Support Operations (Basic Exterior Firefighter Operations – pre-requisite).

Please make sure you are well rested, hydrated, and prepared to train. Bring water and/or Gatorade so that you may stay hydrated throughout the sessions.
