WATER RESCUE SAFETY

- Never wear firefighting PPE for water rescue.
- Always wear a PFD within ten feet of water.
- Don't tie rescuers or victims into a rope in moving water.
- Do not allow emotions to override the safety of the rescuers.
- Only enter the water as a last resort & only with the proper equipment & training
