

BRUSH FIRE SAFETY

- **★**Operations on the ground (off the apparatus)
 - **★** Watch for Brush Truck apparatus
 - **★Stay in communication/visual contact**
 - **★** Watch for changing conditions
- **★**Operations on the apparatus
 - *Keeps hands and limbs inside rig
 - Do not stand on rear step while moving
 - **★**Watch for snags/dead trees
 - Drivers should avoid hitting trees when possible



Special Considerations

- Fire Weather Conditions Temperature, Relative Humidity, Windspeed and Direction - National Weather Service
- NFPA 1977 Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting and Urban Interface Fire
- Brush Fire Rapid Intervention (R.I.T.) A designated Brush Truck with the following capabilities
- Advanced Medical Care, Hoisting / Lifting equipment, Chainsaws, Hydration.
- Familiarization with Land Navigation. GPS / Maps
