BRUSH FIRE SAFETY

- ★ Operations on the ground (off the apparatus)
 - ★ Watch for Brush Truck apparatus
 - ★ Stay in communication/visual contact
 - ★ Watch for changing conditions
- ★ Operations on the apparatus
 - ★ Keeps hands and limbs inside rig
 - ★ Do not stand on rear step while moving
 - ★ Watch for snags/dead trees
 - ★ Drivers should avoid hitting trees when possible



Special Considerations

- Fire Weather Conditions - Temperature, Relative Humidity, Windspeed and Direction - National Weather Service
- NFPA 1977 Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting and Urban Interface Fire
- Brush Fire Rapid Intervention (R.I.T.) – A designated Brush Truck with the following capabilities
- Advanced Medical Care, Hoisting / Lifting equipment, Chainsaws, Hydration.
- Familiarization with Land Navigation. GPS / Maps
